<u>Tuesday</u>, <u>Jan 7- The Brother Embroidery Club</u>. This is an ongoing monthly club for 2025. Come and learn how to make the most of your Brother embroidery machine while completing small projects as well as enjoying individual sewing time.

<u>Wednesdays</u>, <u>Jan. 8</u>, <u>15</u>, <u>22- Sewing Basics</u>. This 3-session class will introduce you to various features of your machine and provide information on topics such as thread choice, tension settings, and sewing techniques. In addition, a small project will be completed.

<u>Thursday</u>, <u>Jan. 9-The Sewing Club</u>. This is the first meeting of the Thursday club which emphasizes quick projects as well as individual time to sew. Join us to learn new skills and techniques each month. (There is also a Saturday section of this club—see below).

<u>Friday, Jan. 17-The Janome Embroidery Club.</u> This is the first meeting of this club which includes instructions and demonstrations to enhance your embroidery experiences on your Janome Embroidery machine. Small projects and individual sewing time are included.

<u>Saturday</u>, <u>Jan 18-The Sewing Club</u>. This is the first meeting of the Saturday club which emphasizes quick projects as well as individual time to sew. Join us to learn new skills and techniques each month. (There is also a Thursday section of this club—see above).

<u>Tuesday</u>, <u>Jan. 21-Sit & Sew.</u> Come and work on your own projects in the comfort of our relaxing classroom.



Do you have difficulty sometimes with thread getting tangled or knotted at the beginning and end of your sewing? Or maybe you have experienced your fabric being pushed through the hole in your needleplate or gathered when you first start sewing. Using **leaders and enders** may solve these problems. Simply have a small square of two layers of fabric on hand to start the sewing,

and then immediately continue over to your project pieces and the thread will transfer smoothly. You can do the same process at the end. Stop in the shop for a quick demonstration if you have any questions about this technique!
