We have recently received many new solid fabrics in a variety of colors that are sure to add a pop to your latest sewing or quilting project.



These bolts are arranged by color and are mixed in with corresponding blenders. Bring samples of fabric with you so that you can spot the exact color that you need. It is also a good idea to keep some solids and blenders in your personal stash so they will be on hand for new projects.

SERVICE CENTER SUGGESTION

Chuck, our Service Center Manager, wants to remind you to make certain the spool cap is flush against the thread on the spool pin as far as

it can be, so it is secure. If it is not, the thread can become entangled on the pin which could cause thread breakage, uneven stitches, and tension problems. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask Chuck to explain the correct way to load the thread.

This month's notion is <u>Triangle Tailor's Chalk</u> by Clover.
