This month's notion is <u>Fray Check</u> by <u>Dritz</u>. It is a liquid sealant that will keep your fabric from becoming unstable on the edges. Some fabrics seem to naturally fray more than others—some even to the point where your carefully cut applique pieces may no longer be the right size. Also, you may have some already pieced projects that could use some extra added protection in a seam area. <u>Fri., 11/7 – Lattice Table Runner</u>. This class was so popular in the past, we brought it back again this year! This elegant runner is easy to put together with border fabric as well as you own favorite prints. It is also reversible.

<u>Sat., 11/8 – Bag of the Month.</u> This month we are again offering the RulerWrap class. Also, if you have other bag projects that you need to finish bring them along, too!

<u>Tues.</u>, 11/11 - 3 <u>Yard Quilt</u>. This quilt is from the **Panel Perfect** book and is entitled "Bombay". You can use holiday fabrics and a panel as our sample in the shop does, or choose your own combination of fabrics. Join us for this easy quilt that you could finish on your own in time for the holidays.

<u>Weds., 11/12 and 11/19 – Sit & Sew</u>. Bring you own projects and relax in our comfortable classroom for a day of sewing and conversation. We would be happy to help you with your projects.

Fri., 11/14 – Simple Sewing Project #3 -Tote Bag. If you are new to sewing or returning to sewing—join us to make this easy tote bag that you will enjoy or you will enjoy gifting. You will learn new skills that will help you in all of your sewing adventures.

<u>Thurs.</u>, <u>11/20 – Intermediate RulerWork</u>. This class is a follow-up to our Beginner's RulerWork class. We will explore new designs using the same 7 templates with emphasis on more intricate patterns.

<u>Sat.</u>, <u>11/22 – Box Bottom Bag</u>. This is a repeat of our very popular October class! Several bags made from this pattern are on display in the shop (with fall and Halloween colors), but you can certainly use any fabrics. Five-inch squares come together to make this roomy and stylish tote. Please note that this in an intermediate level class.

<u>Tues.</u>, 11/25 – Jelly Roll Pillow. This is a new pattern called Pillows & Placemats. You will use all or part of a 40 piece pre-cut 2-1/2in jelly roll or cut your own 2 1/2" strips. You will also learn to use the Clover – Fabric Tube Maker (we have them available in the Shop).

SERVICE CENTER SUGGESTION

Chuck, our Service Center Manager, says that if you are experiencing difficulty with fabric being forced under the needleplate, your

thread breaking, or inconsistencies in your stitching, it is time to check your machine needle. You should remove the needle and run your finger over both sides to see if there are any rough areas or burrs. If so, replace the needle. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Chuck.



Sometimes we purchase special rulers that enable us to easily cut intricate shapes. It is a good idea to investigate if a ruler has other uses. Often the manufacturer's website will provide information, patterns, or videos demonstrating alternate ways to use the ruler so you will get the most value for your purchase.
